# Report From the Treasurer

I'm pleased to report that we finished the last fiscal year with strong finances that enabled the club to make significant investment in the club's equipment and facilities.

The highlights of the last fiscal year include: Income generated more than the budgeted amount of \$60 thousand as a result of having full membership and receiving higher than anticipated green fees, and cart fees. Operating expenses were less than budgeted by \$136 thousand due lower healthcare costs and lower liability insurance costs. In addition, the Board of Governors approved \$60 thousand in capital investment, for a second Workman not included in the 2026 Budget. Therefore, the total capital spent last fiscal year was \$358 thousand which includes equipment arriving in October.

At the end of the fiscal year, Black Hall Club posted a \$77 thousand increase to our reserves. The cash position at the club is at \$561 thousand over our recommended threshold of \$500 thousand. Turning to the fiscal year that we have just entered, the Board of Governors reviewed and approved this fiscal year's budget. Last year's Budget included a budget using no reserves. This year the budget is also based on using no reserves. Therefore, the Board determined that in order to meet our budgetary expenses, dues will be increased by 8.9%. During budget deliberations the focus was on sufficiently funding operations to smoothly run the club, fulfilling ongoing capital needs, remaining debt free, and maintaining a healthy cash reserve for larger projects and emergency needs. All of these goals were met with the new fiscal year budget, and I look forward to keeping you apprised as the new year unfolds

# **House Report**

The dining room is now closed for the season. Once again, many THANKS to Kathy Lane and her staff! I'd also like to extend a special thanks to Nancy Tiffany and Ron Furr for all the work they do to support the House Committee.

The Back Nine Bathroom will be closed for the season in the first week in November and will reopen on April 1st (weather dependent).

Reminder: All lockers must be emptied no later than December 31st to allow for our annual cleaning. Lockers will be available for next season on March 1, 2025, upon payment of the annual locker fee (shoe locker - \$45; half locker - \$80).

# Looking Ahead: Clubhouse Improvements and Long-Range Planning

As mentioned over the past year, we've been working with edm studio, an architectural firm, to help create a long-range plan for repairing and modernizing our clubhouse. As part of this process, edm reviewed the building, met with staff, and held discussions with both the House Committee and the Board Governors. The information gathered from these meetings has been compiled into a preliminary report that has been shared with both the House and BOG. In the coming months, we'll be sharing the full findings, discussing priorities and options with the entire membership.

One of the most pressing issues identified during the review is the clubhouse basement. During the peak summer weeks, humidity levels have been a recurring problem that



must be addressed. The report also noted the need for better storage space for golf bags, carts, and food and beverage supplies. Several options are being explored, and immediate steps are already underway to improve the situation. The House Committee unanimously agreed that this is our top priority and funds have been allocated in this year's budget to tackle these issues. We look forward to sharing updates as the work progresses and for you to see the improvements when you return in the spring!

## **Head Chef Replacement**

We have started the difficult job of looking for Kathy Lane's replacement. Our 1st choice is to replace Kathy with a new chef. The position has been posted on Indeed and we have received a few resumes. We will be conducting interviews in November. 


#### **Green Committee Thank You**

#### A Year In Review

This past year, 13 new members joined Black Hall Club (9 Regular, 4 Associate). We currently have active waitlists for both Regular and Associate memberships. Member referrals continue to be our strongest source of growth—86% of new and waitlist candidates were introduced by current members.

Our membership inquiries totaled 139, a 14% decrease from last year, but interest remains steady throughout the season.

Resignations: 24 members left during the year, including 7 Regular Members, 1 Associate Member, 5 Senior Members who switched to Osprey and 10 Ospreys (4 of whom passed away).

### **Communications & Engagement:**

We continue to stay connected through club emails, the Osprey newsletter, text alerts, and our members-only Facebook group. The club website remains a useful hub—over 55% of visits now come from mobile devices.

Overall, Black Hall remains strong and engaged, with a growing community and continued interest from new prospects. It's also interesting to observe that the average age of our membership currently stands at 62 years old.


