All About the Greens

When the weather warms up, we will be installing a new Turfhound mat on the practice range. The Turfhound product utilizes dual density technology, comprising a foam core with a hard bottom layer and a synthetic grass top layer. The mat will not be as hard as the existing mat, making it easier on the joints.

The new mat has a tee insert sleeve that allows you to use the standard tee of your choice, and there is a section of longer length "rough" turf at each station.

This product has been installed all around the country, at some of America's premier courses such as Merion and Pebble Beach. Locally, it has been installed at Bulls Bridge, Brooklawn and Shelter Harbor. Turfhound is presently rebuilding their website, but a good description of the technology is on this YouTube video: <u>Turf Hound Golf Mat</u>

Fairway and greens aerification

Our maintenance crew has done an excellent job completing all the fairway aerification. All the tees except for the par3s have also been completed. This is a big job and getting it done early allows for better conditions this Spring. Our superintendent Chris Konow is implementing a revamped green aerification plan this year that should result in better green health. The aerification of the greens will be done as soon as the weather allows.

Tee boxes will be open on April 5, weather permitting!

April brings the start of a new golf season. The Maintenance staff has made a tremendous effort throughout the winter season in order to have the course in great shape as early as possible. When you see them please let them know you appreciate their efforts.

The practice range will be opening April 6th using just the artificial turf mat and then on April 20 comes the Opening Day tournament which is a great way to start the season and become acquainted with your fellow members.

During the winter months I've noticed some golfers have been ignoring that the course is closed on Monday mornings until noon. Monday morning closure allows the crew to accomplish maintenance without interference from golfers. Please abide by this rule throughout the year. Rounds of golf have been steadily increasing since the renewed interest after Covid hit. With that there is the potential for less than enjoyable rounds due to SLOW PLAY. We can all do our part to avoid slow play by paying attention to some of the following situations.

Be ready to play when it's your turn by:

- Making club selection and getting your practice swings out of the way while others are hitting.
- When riding together don't sit and watch each other hit but separate and both get ready when it's time to hit.
- On the greens pick out you line while others are putting and be ready to go when it's your turn.
- Save your story telling for walking down the fairway. There is nothing more annoying then someone telling stories when it's time to tee off.
- Pay attention when a ball is hit off-line so you will spend less time looking.
- Play READY GOLF.
- Speak up to your playing partners when you notice your group is falling behind.

We all have a responsibility to keep OUR COURSE in the best playing condition possible. There is nothing more aggravating than to see a huge divot just left in the fairway as a tribute to a players bad swing. Replacing divots depends on the depth and integrity of the divot.

The deeper the divot, the more likely it is to have soil and roots attached to it, which makes it a good candidate for replacement. A shallow divot with no roots or soil has no chance of survival, so there's no point replacing it.

Do your part by:

- Replacing or reseeding your divots and other divots that are missed.
- If you are not riding pick up a seed mix container on the 1st tee and drop it off when done near the fountain on 9.





- Fix your ball mark on the green and any others that you notice.
- Rake your mess and others properly in the traps.




